REPORT OF THE UKRAINIAN BIRD RINGING CENTRE

"KIEV"

Ukrainian Bird Ringing Centre was found in the Institute of Zoology (National Academy of Sciences) in May of 1992.

Since 1994 Ukrainian ornithologists had begun to use Ukrainian rings with inscription "Kiev". During 1994-2008 206 536 birds of 262 species get Ukrainian rings. The rings of other Schemes were used in Ukraine. A part of our ornithologists use also rings "Moskwa", "Helgoland".

Staff. The scheme involves three persons staff, two of them are scientific (Anatoliy Poluda – Head of the scheme, Svetlana Tshukanova) and one technical.

Rings. There are 22 different sizes of Ukrainian rings in use. Rings are imported from Poland (Aranea) and United Kingdom (Porzana) as required. Ringers don't have to pay for the rings.

Data management. All ringing data (for rings "Kiev" and "Moskwa" are computerised. Our database of the recoveries includes 6693 records.
