Belgrade Centre for Animal Marking was established 1993 as a department of Natural History Museum. The numbers of active ringers and total number of ringed birds were rather small in the beginning, primarily because of the small budget and small stocks of rings, but in a short period of time the numbers of ringers, followed by annual numbers of ringed birds increased.

In a period 1993-2003, with Belgrade rings was ringed 118191 birds of 218 species. Number of ringed birds through age categories is given in table.

Belgrade Ringing Centre has 42 ringers, mainly ornithologists amateurs, but also and professionals. For ringing licence person has to pass an exam.

All recovery data - foreign recoveries as well as recoveries of birds with Belgrade rings are computerised (Excel base). Ringing data from 2004. are computerised too (Access base), but unfortunately huge quantity of information before 2004. are still handled manually.
